Hello David. Yes, all the 2020 reports have been sent to Georgia Safe Dams. Normally per their procedure, we send the previous years reports to GSD in March of the following year. ## Scott,

I just received the following from Ga Safe Dams in response to a recent ORR, literally minutes before your reply to me. To put this in perspective, I am going to quote from both of your communications today:

**Big Canoe POA:** "Hello David. Yes, all the 2020 reports have been sent to Georgia Safe Dams. Normally per their procedure, we send the previous years reports to GSD in March of the following year. And every other year at the same time, per their requirements, we also provide the engineering report that Geosyntec creates. This year we sent the inspection reports early as they requested."

**SAFE DAMS/EPD:** "The Safe Dams program is not in receipt of any inspection records from 2020 for Lake Petit Dam (other than the Geosyntec Report you've identified in your request). All dam owners in Georgia have until April 30, 2021 to submit inspections conducted in 2020 to EPD."

Note: The reference to the "Geosyntec Report you've identified in your request" was a reference I made in my ORR to the March/April 2020 report, so the State is saying clearly that they have not received any quarterly inspection reports since then, nor the most recent Geosyntec Report (Sept/Oct I think)

The above statements were literally received within 12 minutes of each other. It doesn't appear possible that both statements are correct. I'm running another story on this in the near future, and this data is also being compiled as part of a report to the Governor's Office. Either somebody is dropping the ball here resulting in massive confusion, or somebody is lying. I do not wish to believe that any parties are lying, but again, there doesn't appear to be an explanation so far for the conflicting statements.
