In accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Safe Dams Act of 1978 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, this permit is issued for the following:

Operation of a water impounding structure, hereafter referred to as a dam, located at Latitude 34° 27' 45" and Longitude 84° 17' 25" in Pickens County (special directions--Take Cove Rd. east from Jasper and follow signs). The dam is an earth dam (earth, concrete, rockfill, etc.) 126.4 feet in height with a volume at maximum pool of approximately 6000 acre feet.

This permit is conditioned upon the permittee complying with the attached conditions of operation, which are hereby made a part of this permit.

The Application for Dam Operation Permit dated June 22, 1979 and the statements and supporting data submitted thereafter are filed with the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources and are hereby made a part of this permit.

This permit is effective from the date first above written and is subject to modification or revocation on evidence of noncompliance with any of the provisions of the Georgia Safe Dams Act or any of the Rules and Regulations promulgated pursuant thereto; or with any representation made in the above mentioned application or the statements and supporting data entered therein or attached thereto; or with any conditions of this permit.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The piezometers which have been cut off on the second and third upper beams must be repaired and protected.
2. The balance of the piezometers in the dam must be located, repaired or replaced.
3. The drainage ditch at the base of the dam must be regraded and cleaned so that the toe drainage system outlets are exposed.
4. The above work must be completed by July 15, 1980.
