- 1. A number of small bare areas were noted on upstream and downstream slope. These should be regrassed with a low-growing grass such as Bermuda or fescue.
- 2. The two lowest berm toe drains should be cleaned out. The debris is clogging up the drains and causing backup.
- 3. There is excessive vegetation along the left edge of the downstream slope that should be cleared.
- 4. You should continue to send quarterly piezometers readings
