Subject/Issue(s) Discussed: Mr. MacDonald called to discuss the bathymetric survey which was completed for the subject dam. Mr. MacDonald indicated that the volume in the lake fell between the volume in our records and the volume originally used in the EAP, but was closer to the volume originally used in the EAP. Mr. MacDonald indicated that the owner intends to use the volume identified in the bathymetric survey to update the inundation mapping and asked if that was acceptable to the program. Additionally, Mr. MacDonald intends to use this new bathymetric survey, as appropriate, to develop plans for the rehabilitation/replacement of the low-level drain and the spillway. I concurred that as long as the survey was stamped by the surveyor, it would be acceptable to use these volumes in the EAP and for further design. *

It was agreed that the bathymetric survey would be submitted with the EAP. It is anticipated that the updated EAP should be submitted in early to mid-August as indicated in their letter from February. A schedule for submittal of the remainder of the design package will be discussed when the EAP is submitted.
