It has been determined that the Emergency Action Plan (EAP) submitted electronically on December 2, 2022, at 5:18 pm, for the subject dam meets the requirements of the Georgia Rules for Dam Safety 391-3-8.11 and is hereby approved pending submittal of a final version.

Please note that the above document was reviewed for conformance to an approved format such as FEMA Publication No. P-64, but not for accuracy. As an owner of the dam, it is your responsibility to ensure the accuracy of the document. The EAP is a living document and requires regular review and updating as personnel, downstream development, the dam itself, and other factors may not remain constant throughout the life of the document. FEMA recommends EAPs be reviewed at least annually and updated as needed. If any update to the EAP occurs, a copy should be provided to this office.

Upon receipt of the final version of the EAP, the concurrence page will be signed by the Safe Dams Program Manager and returned to you. Please distribute the final version of the approved EAP with the completed concurrence signature pages to all individuals on the distribution list. The document will be considered complete once the concurrence pages, with all signatures, have been received by this office.
